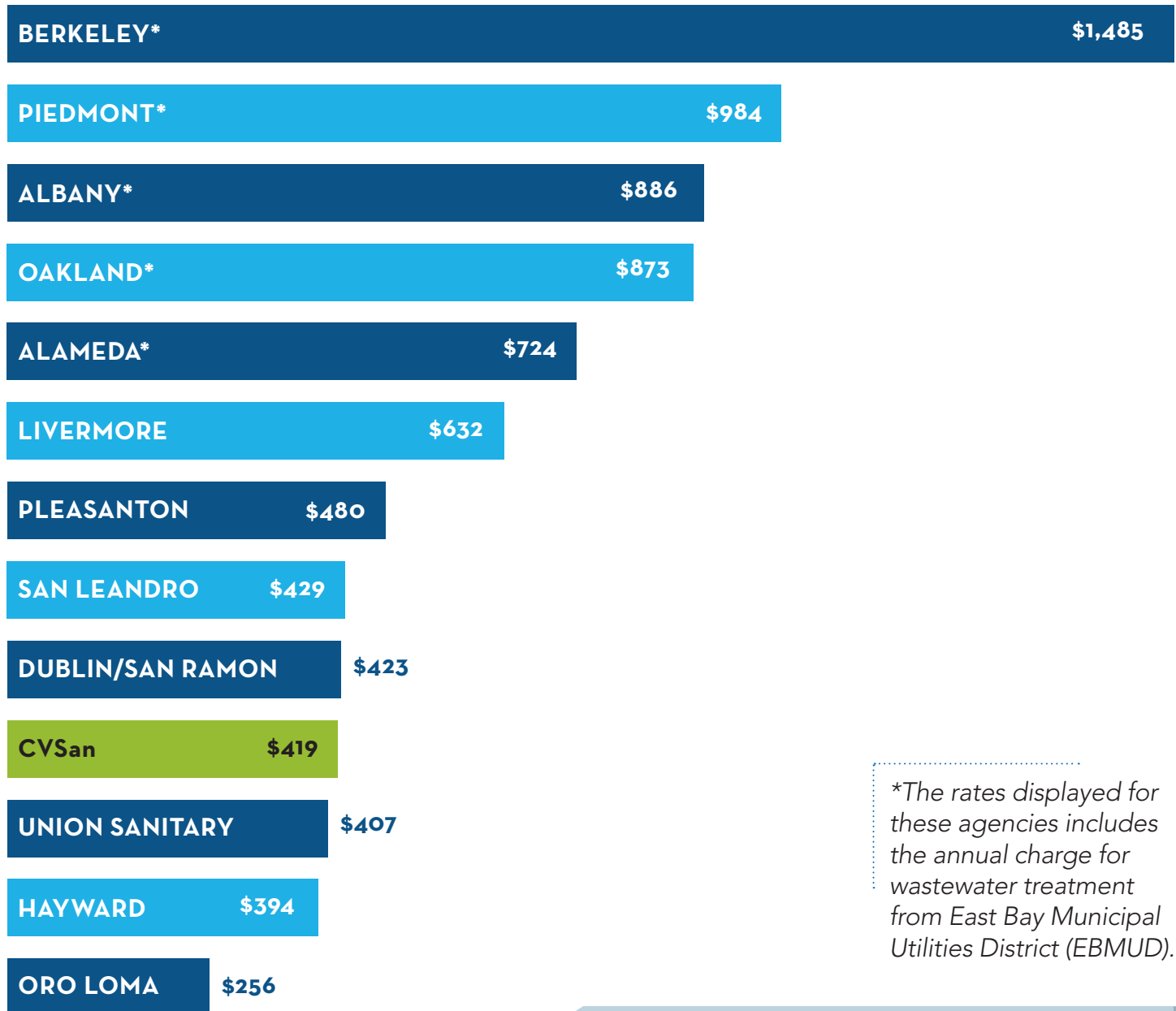


ALAMEDA COUNTY SINGLE-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL SEWER SERVICE CHARGES COMPARISON

Sewer Service Charges are annual fees for a building to receive sewer service and can be found on your property tax bill. This chart shows the annual cost for a single-family home to have sewer service in Castro Valley Sanitary District's (CVSan) boundaries compared to other areas of Alameda County. The rates shown are valid for July 1, 2018 to June 30, 2019.



**The rates displayed for these agencies includes the annual charge for wastewater treatment from East Bay Municipal Utilities District (EBMUD).*

HOW DOES CVSan CALCULATE ITS RATES?

Every two years, CVSan creates a budget to maintain its wastewater infrastructure. The Sewer Service Charge is calculated by dividing the annual budget by the number of buildings connected to CVSan's wastewater system. CVSan has one of the lowest rates in Alameda County and lower than the average annual charge in the State of California.
