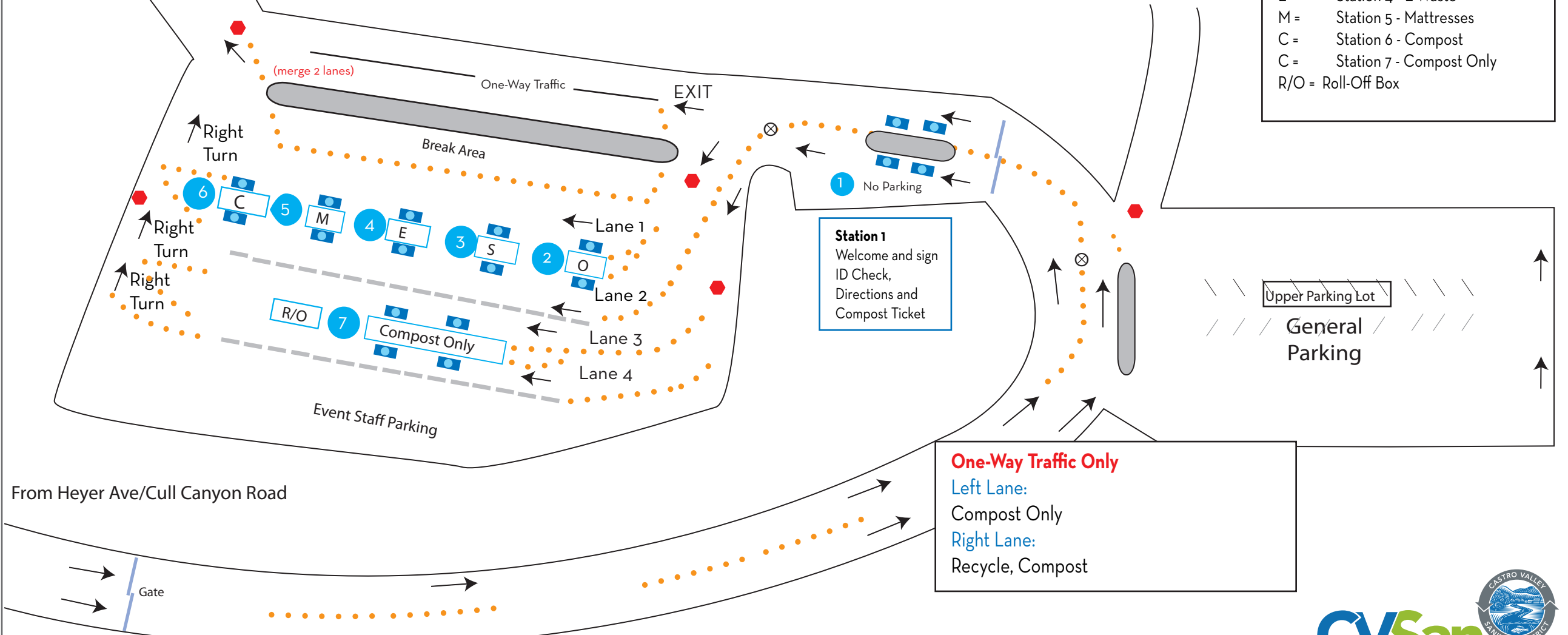

FREE COMPOST: three 1-cubic foot bags per household (single-family or multi-family apartment) or business. Supplies are limited and will be distributed 1st come, 1st served. Vehicle loading assistance is available. Participation in the Recycle Collection is not required to receive free compost, however you must be a CVSan resident or business (bring ID or bill).
